- Minimum 2 Board of Directors positions represented by young people
- Activity organizing committees represented by young people
- Less formal structure and jargon
- Mentors (experienced members of the Board paired with new members)
- Less formal and intimidating locations for Board meetings

For volunteer opportunities:

- PEI program
- Contacts with school boards, cégep, youth organizations
- Display/representation at places where young people go
- Symplik
